

Can photovoltaic panels still be sold when they expire

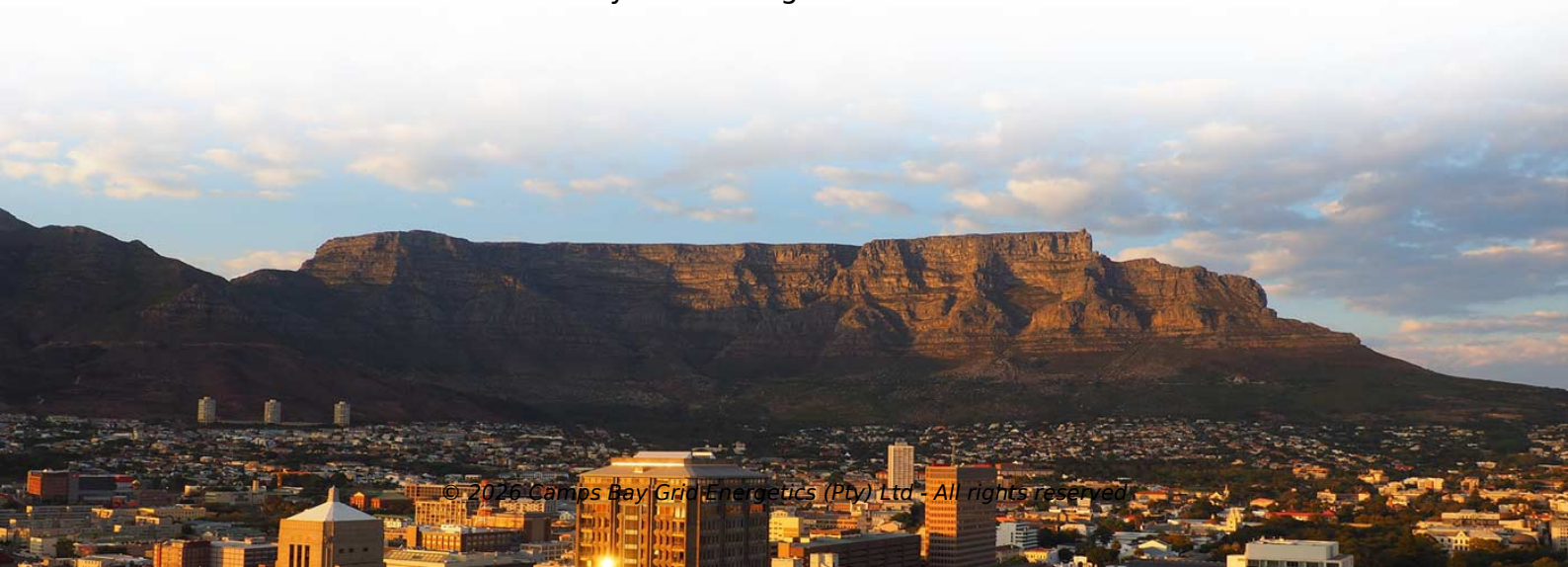
