If a cell goes bad in a battery that features cell-level fusing, the fuse associated with that cell will activate and open the circuit, preventing the damaged cell from further charging or discharging. Historically, wire bonding was just about the only reasonable way that one could achieve cell-level fusing. This is a technique that involves using thin wires made of materials such as gold or aluminum. If wire bonding sounds a bit overwhelming, fret not. Battery hookup makes a special nickel conductor that is specifically made for cell-level fusing. These specially cut nickel conductors.
