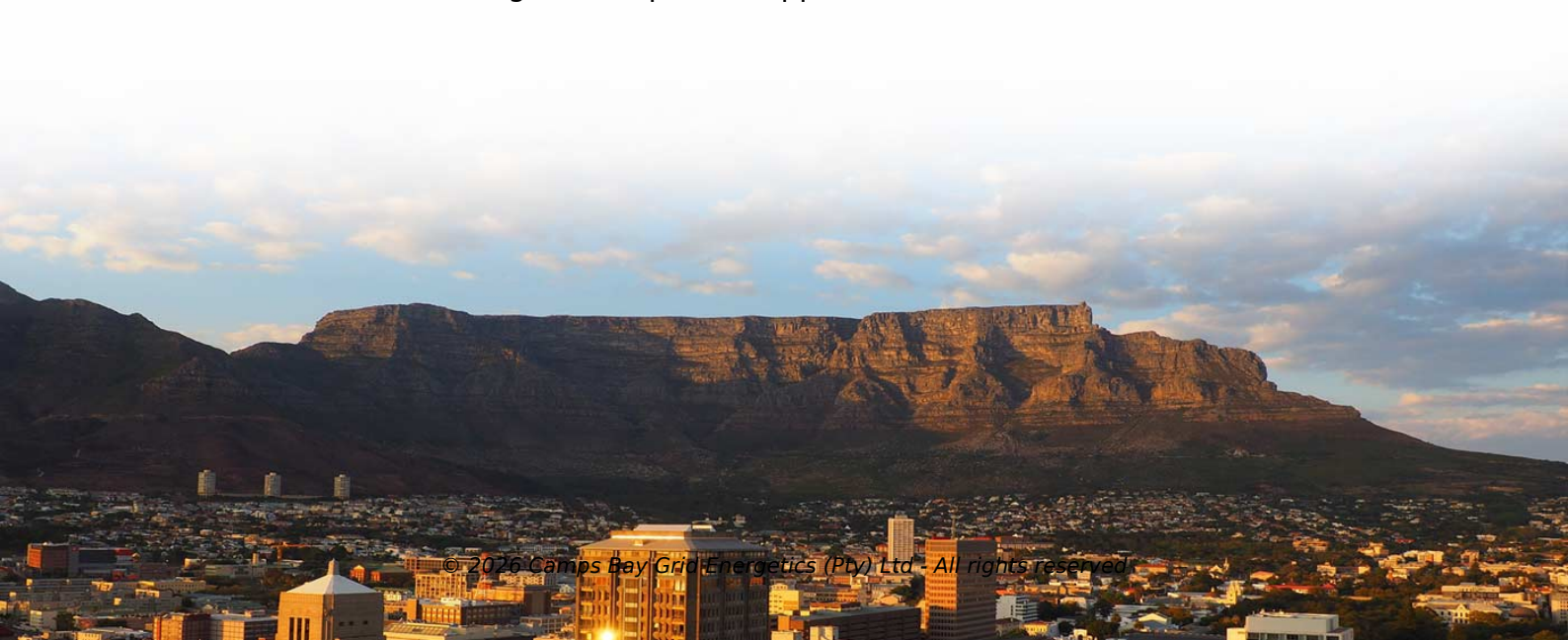

Overview

The polarity of a battery power supply can usually be determined by examining the battery terminals. The battery's positive terminal is typically marked with a plus sign (+), and the negative terminal is marked with a minus sign (-). The polarity of a cylindrical power supply, such as an AA, AAA, or CR2032 battery, can typically be determined by examining the battery's markings and physical characteristics. Most cylindrical batteries have a flat top and a crown. Crown batteries are typically lead-acid batteries used in industrial and commercial applications. The polarity of a crown power supply can usually be determined by examining the power supply terminals. The positive terminal is typically marked with a plus sign (+), and the negative terminal is marked with a minus sign (-). Yes, battery polarity can be reversed if the power supply is connected in the wrong orientation. For example, suppose a power supply is connected with the positive terminal connected to the negative side of a circuit and the negative terminal connected to the positive side. Suppose you reverse the polarity when installing a battery, connecting the positive terminal to the negative side of the circuit and the negative terminal to the positive side. In that case, it can cause damage to the power supply.
